Regent Communications of Flint ("Regent of Flint") is committed to equal employment opportunities in staffing its six radio stations. During the preceding one-year period (June 2007 to May 2008), Regent of Flint has participated in a number of activities designed to ensure broad outreach and to inform members of the community about opportunities in broadcast employment. Regent of Flint has experienced no notable outreach difficulties during the one-year period preceding this filing. During this time, Regent of Flint has:

1. Participated in Job Fairs at Lansing Community College, Baker College and the Great Lakes Broadcasting Conference. When combined with Job Fairs attended in the 2007 report Regent Broadcasting of Flint has participated in 6 Job Fairs over the two year period.
2. Maintained an on-going internship program with local colleges and universities, including University of Michigan, Baker College, Mott Community College and Kettering University. Additionally, Regent expanded Internship opportunities to high school students. Over the past year, the Flint stations have employed over 55 interns.
3. Provided thorough, quality on-going training programs for its sales, engineering and programming employees. The training programs are designed to allow them to acquire skills that would qualify them for higher level positions.
4. Participated in an activity designed to disseminate information about broadcasting opportunities. Regent Broadcasting of Flint's O.M. continued to teach a course in communications at Mott College.

By employing these and a variety of other methods and initiatives, Regent of Flint has complied with both the letter and the spirit of the Commission's equal employment opportunity rules, 47 CFR § 73.2080(c)(2). II. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

Regent of Flint engages in numerous programs and activities designed to broadly disseminate information about professional opportunities in broadcasting at our stations and to reach out to the community to enable individuals to acquire the skills needed to pursue careers in broadcasting. The following initiatives, together with those described in Regent of Flint's previous Public File Report, are sufficient to satisfy the Commission's EEO requirements under Section 73.2080(c)(2).

Job Fair Attendance

In 2007, Regent Broadcasting of Flint had representatives at Job Fairs at the Great Lakes Broadcasting Conference on March 14th, The Baker College Career fair on April 20th, and the Lansing Community College on October 27th. When combined with job fairs attended in 2006 Regent of Flint has participated in 6. At these job fairs we collect information from people interested in working in the broadcast industry as well as collect resumes of people interested in our internship program.

Internship Program Outreach Initiative

Regent of Flint maintains internship programs with the following local colleges and universities: University of Michigan-Flint, Baker College, Mott Community College and Kettering University. Currently, 25 interns, including two high school students, are participating in the internship program, which is designed to help students acquire the skills necessary for careers in broadcast.

On-the-Job Training

Regent of Flint provides on-going training programs for its sales, engineering and programming employees to allow them to acquire skills that would qualify them for higher level positions. Several opportunities are given to sales persons to attend training and seminars. Additionally, the Chief Engineer was sent to attend the Engineering Conference at the National Association of Broadcasters Convention in Las Vegas, NV.

Activity Designed to Disseminate Information about Broadcasting Employment Opportunities

Regent Broadcasting of Flint makes its facilities available to several community groups and schools for tours. In the 2006 and 2007 calendar years numerous Scouting groups toured our facility as well as groups from the Flint Community Schools.

Additionally, Regent Broadcasting of Flint's Operations Manager, J. Patrick, teaches a communications class at Mott College in Flint.
